	Date	Wednesday Afternoon Sessions 1:45pm – 2:45pm	
Wk 1	1 st May	WELCOME to Term 2: MARK MAKING Mark making is the act of creating marks on a surface. This helps children see that marks can carry a message. Come along to do some mark making with pencils and textas on our giant piece of paper!	
Wk 2	8 th May	FARM LIFE AND PLAY What kind of animals live on the farm? Which one is your favourite? Today we will have some fun with farm animal-based activities and play together.	
Wk 3	15 th May	FINE MOTOR Fine motor activities engage the small muscles of the body, such as the fingers and eyes. Can you thread the spools onto the string? Or maybe you would like to draw a picture or put a puzzle together. Today is all about working on our fine motor skills!	
Wk 4	22 nd May	TMAG (Tasmanian Museum and Art Gallery) Excursion <i>'mapiya lumi around here'</i> We will meet at 1:20 pm at the public entrance to TMAG. While there we will be exploring the exhibition, <i>mapiya lumi around here</i> , a specially developed, age-appropriate museum experience for young children (ages 0-7) and their carers. Our session begins at 1:30pm and will end at 2:30pm.	
Wk 5	29 th May	 NURSERY RHYMES AND PLAY Nursery rhymes and songs are fun and have a huge impact on children's language development. The first part of the session will be craft and play before we enjoy singing some of our favourite nursery rhymes together.	
Wk 6	5 th June	 BUSY BUILDERS During this week's session we will be exploring building with blocks of all different sizes. There will also be other activities on the day, including arts and crafts.	
Wk 7	12 th June	GROSS MOTOR A range of outdoor activities designed to develop gross motor skills, including games and an obstacle course.	
Wk 8	19 th June	WINTER Brrrr. It's cold outside! Can you make a snowman using our playdough or maybe you'd like to make a snowflake. Today is all about cold weather activities and animals.	
Wk 9	26 th June	TRAINS AND TRANSPORTATION Transportation is an important part of everyday life. How do you get to school? Have you ever ridden on a train? We're exploring all types of transport today.	
Wk 10	3 rd July	NURSERY RHYMES AND PLAY The first part of the session will be craft and play before we enjoy singing some of our favourite nursery rhymes together. What's your favourite nursery rhyme?	

All sessions are run in either the Kinder classroom or the outdoor Kindergarten area, unless stated otherwise.
