| Wk 2 | 7 th May | FINE MOTOR Fine motor activities engage the small muscles of the body, such as the fingers and eyes. Can you thread the spools onto the string? Or maybe you would like to draw a picture or put a puzzle together. Today is all about working on our fine motor skills! |  |
